

Research Training Fellowship for Clinicians, 2015

India Alliance announces the launch of the competition for the 'Research Training Fellowship for Clinicians'.

This opportunity is aimed at providing clinicians with an opportunity to perform high quality basic and clinical research in a laboratory and/or clinical environment of their choice.

Eligibility: For those who wish to undertake substantial training through high-quality research under the supervision of senior scientists with expertise in clinical and basic science research.

- For those who are in the final year of MD/MS/DM/DNB or have completed their MD/MS/DM/DNB at the time of application.
- Allied health professionals who are in the final year of their Master's degree or have completed their Masters at the time of application.
- Candidates holding a faculty position can also apply
- Only Indians can apply to this competition

Provision: It offers

- 2 years support to cover personal support and research & training cost.
- An opportunity to get trained in the area of your interest through a comprehensive training program.
- Support to receive mentorship from the clinical and basic science experts together.
- Provision to pursue an advanced course required for their overall development.
- Clinicians can continue to perform clinical duties on 1 day/week

Training program: The focus of the program should be to train the clinicians in basic, patient-oriented and translational research.

Essentials on the application

- A Training plan
- A not-for-profit Host Institution in India
- A Sponsor at the host institution, who can guarantee space and resources for the duration of the award.

- Principal Supervisor at the Host Institution in whose lab the majority of the training program will be undertaken. This individual can either be a clinician scientist or a basic science researcher.
- A Co-Supervisor can be identified at the Host Institution or at a different place depending on the requirements of the training program. This individual can either be a clinician scientist or a basic researcher, should be able to guide on those aspects of the training program which cannot be covered by the Principal Supervisor's lab.
- One supervisor should be a clinician scientist and other a basic science expert.

Application process: Invites a joint application from the Applicant and the Principal Supervisor
